Common name : Suryavarti

**Family**: Euphorbiaceae

Habitat: Wet places, waste areas, stream beds

**Distribution**: Africa & South Asia, India, Mayanmar, Thailand

**Description**: Herb, leaves ovate, pale green, stipulate,; flowers in terminal racemes,male flowers crowded above, female flowers at base, pedicellate; fruit capsule, depressed, 3-lobed ,have several toxic dolabellane diterpene glucosides, dolabellane diterpenoids and phenylpropanoid glucosides.

**Phytochemicals**: kaempferol, kaempferol derivatives, quercetin, quercetin derivatives, apigenin and its derivatives, acacetin, ß-sitosterol-3-O-ß-glucopyranoside, gallic acid, methyl gallate. Leaf and roots contain xanthone glycosides and a chromone glycoside. Oil extracted from seeds was rich in linoleate and the whole plant contains tannin.

**Medicinal/Economic uses**: Fruit juice used as Cough & colds, blue dye. Extensively standardized as folk-medicine.
